Everyone is having Synods and General Assemblies! The URC just had a synod meeting, the Mexican National Presbyterian church and the Brazilian Presbyterian church are having their General Assemblies in July also. Well, CLIR hasn't had a General Assembly since 2007, so it's time for us also!

CLIR is a Fellowship of confessional, Reformed denominations in Latin America who are *attempting* to work together and help one another in the advance of the Gospel. Just as in North America, there are many obstacles to this endeavor in Latin America. Some of the obstacles are legitimate, others are man-made. However, we are absolutely convinced that cooperation and mutual service will greatly enhance the effectiveness of Gospel proclamation and Reformed testimony in our region.

## Goals for our upcoming General Assembly

The dates for the meeting are September 8 - 12. Some of the specific goals are the following:

- 1) Communicate and share ministry **resources** that our different denominations have, either human talents or educational material
- 2) Plan for **concrete joint projects** in biblical and theological education, missions, leadership training and Catechetical material for youth.
- 3) Encourage the establishment of **distribution centers** for CLIR's literature.
- 4) **\*\*Importantly\*\* - Conferences** by 6 different speakers will encourage and stimulate the group.
