

The all night trip to Bolivia (through Lima, Perú) was tiring. A long line for the visa at the airport ended at 1:30 AM, and my flight to Cochabamba left at 9:00 AM. Uncomfortable chairs effectively kept sleep far away.

Now, as my flight took me from La Paz (at 13,600 feet above sea level!) over even higher mountains, their jagged, snow capped peaks poked out of a fluffy cloud cover, making a gorgeous, powerful impression. I wondered how many people we would have at the conference. Several speakers and I would talk about different Reformation themes. Mine was the importance of "Sola Scriptura" as John

Calvin had defined it. What I didn't know yet was that my notes were back home - I'd forgotten them!

The conference had already begun when I arrived. Thanks to internet, my folks back home scanned my notes and sent them in no time, and I began my first conference of three days.
